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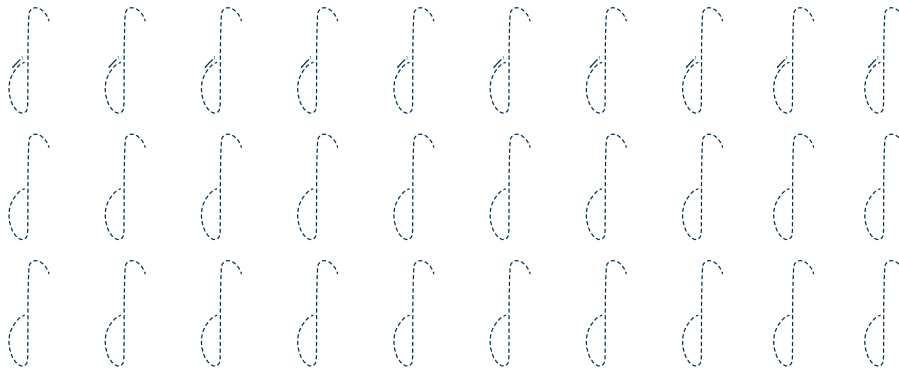
# How one letter is taught

1. Shown in print and in ksiva, stroke order numbered.



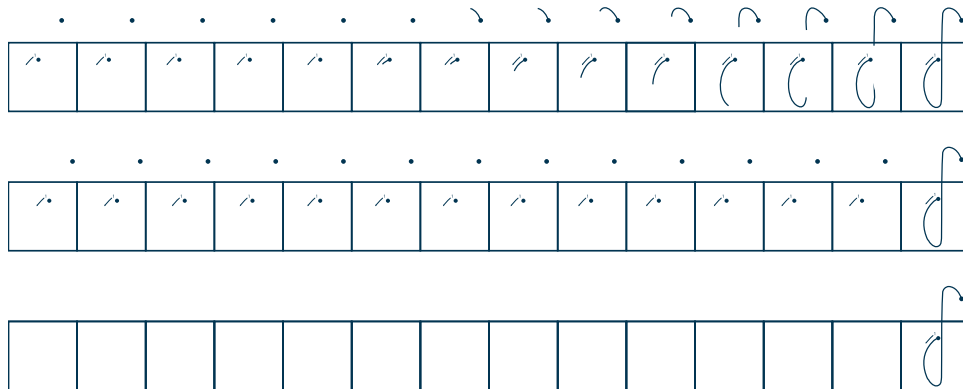
2. The child traces a dotted outline, with the most support.

## FINISH THE LETTERS

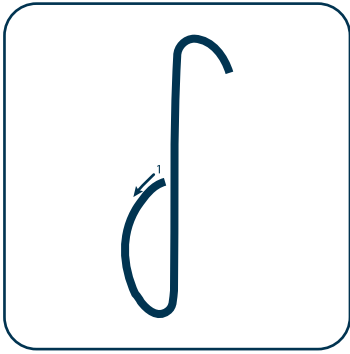


4. Then used in words, built only from letters already taught.

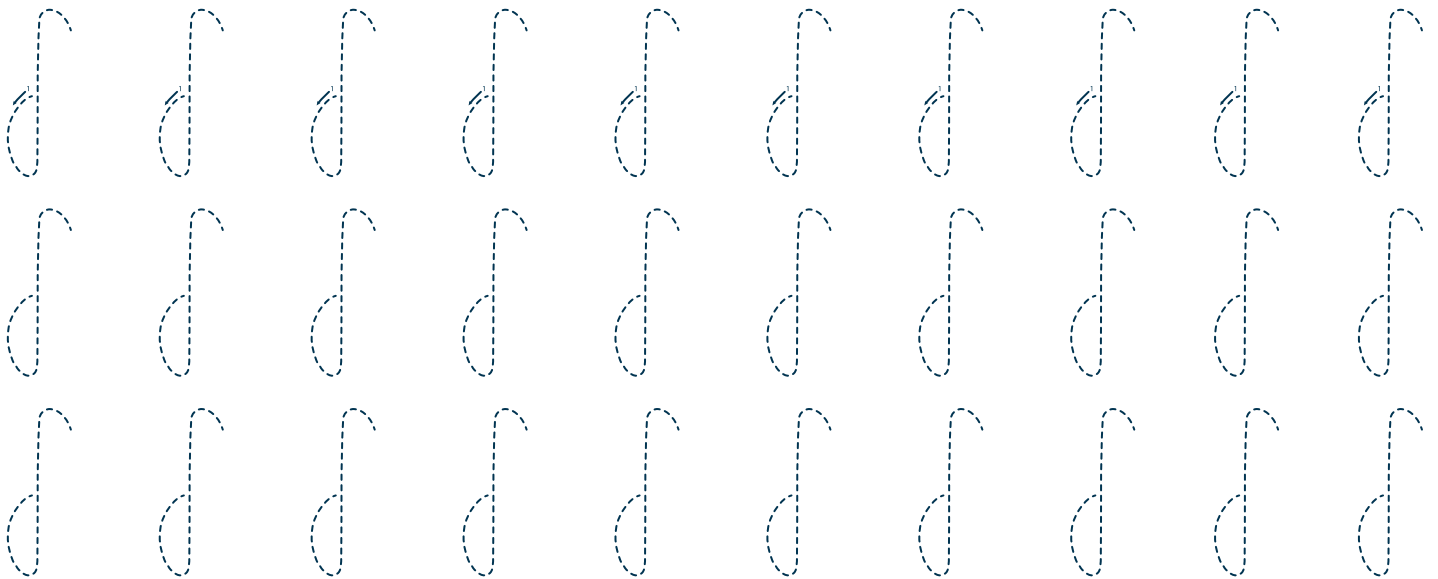


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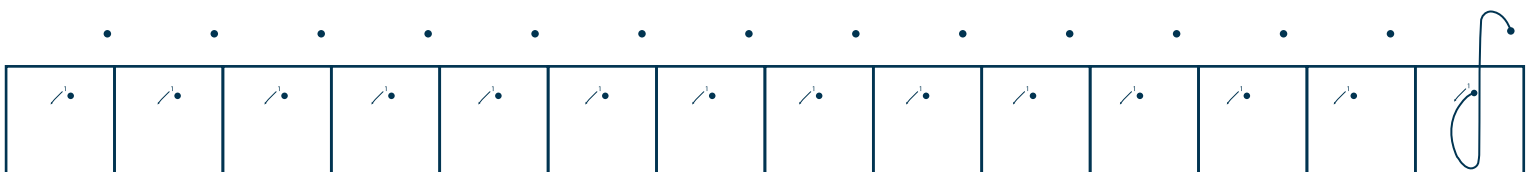
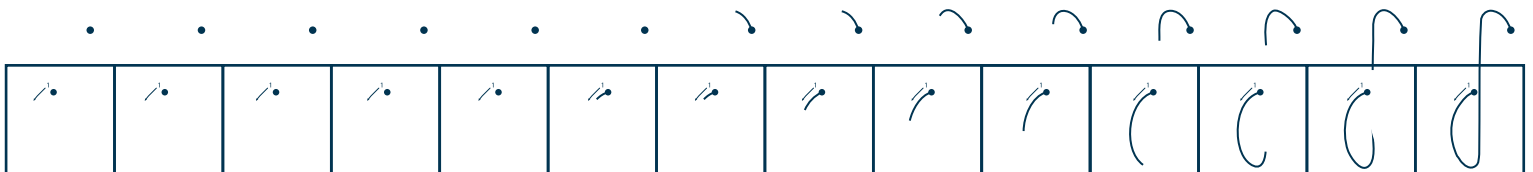
